

## 650V N-Channel Multi-EPI Super-JMOSFET








**Figure 1. On-Region Characteristics**




**Figure 2. Transfer Characteristics**




**Figure 3. On-Resistance Variation vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage**




Figure 7. Breakdown Voltage Variation  
vs Temperature




Figure 8. On-Resistance Variation  
vs Temperature




Figure 9. Maximum Safe Operating Area




Figure 10. Maximum Drain Current vs.  
Case Temperature




Figure 11.  $E_{oss}$  vs. Drain to Source Voltage


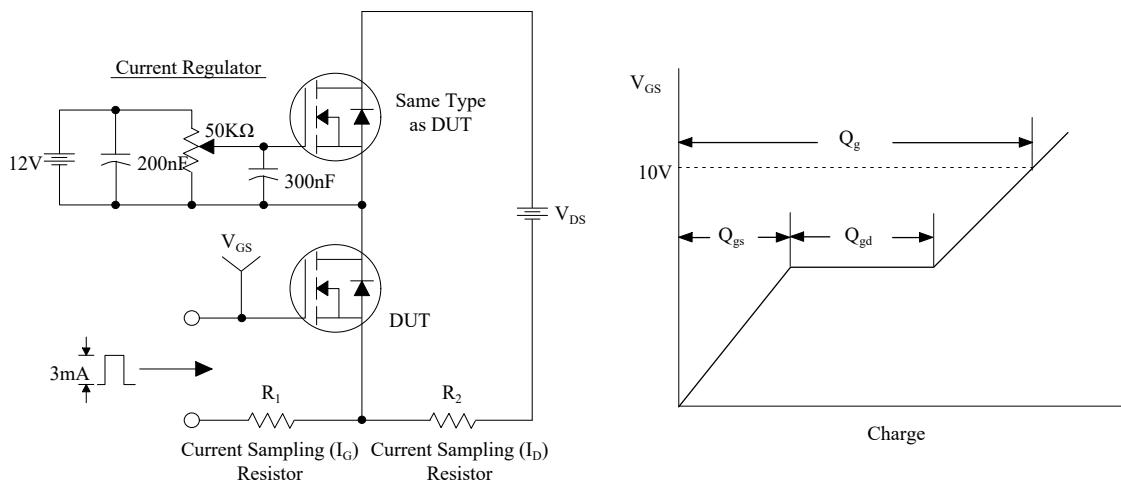



Figure 12. Transient Thermal Response Curve


## Gate Charge Test Circuit & Waveform






## Resistive Switching Test Circuit & Waveforms




## Unclamped Inductive Switching Test Circuit & Waveforms
